Par 69 from the white and yellow tees, measuring at 6042 yards from the whites and 5748 from the yellows and a Par 72 from the reds measuring at 5479 making the course ideal for all standards of player.

The club has thriving Men's, Ladies, Mixed, Seniors and Junior sections and has a friendly atmosphere towards both members and visitors.

COURSE PROTOCOL

No golfer enjoys slow play, so here at St Austell Golf Club we would like to work together with all its members and guests to try and speed up certain areas by following the helpful hints listed below to ensure we maintain a constant pace of play:

- * Be ready to play
- * Play promptly when it is your turn
- * Invite the group behind to play through if you are delaying them
- * Play a provisional ball if you think your ball is lost
- * Leave the putting green quickly when play has been completed
- * Speed up your exit from the green by positioning your bags on the way to the next tee before you putt out

Dress Code

We do ask that you wear appropriate golf clothing and footwear to respect the club, your playing partners and the game.

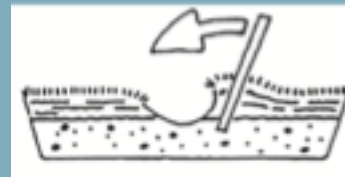
If you are worried about course/ club protocols or dress code, there is more information on our website alternatively please get in contact with the office and someone can help you.

Divot Repairs

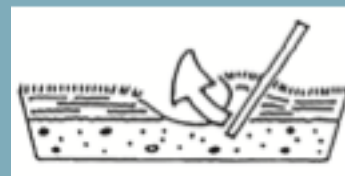
After hitting a great tee shot, nobody likes to find their ball in a divot (see picture below) to help us ensure your great tee shots don't end up like this, please can you replace all divots or use the seed and mix provided at the Clubhouse.

We have highlighted the right and wrong way to repair pitch marks, a non-repaired pitch mark can take over 3 weeks to recover, whereas a repaired pitch mark recovers instantly.
